

# State Approves New Residential Code Without Fire Sprinkler Mandate



On Friday September 27th, the New York State Code Council approved a new family of codes (based on 2018 ICC, with NY specific changes). Due to a strong outcry from NYSBA members, we were able to beat a push for a fire sprinkler mandate in one- and two-family homes and townhouses.

The New York State Department of State (which oversees the Code Council) has created a task force to study the fire sprinkler issue ahead of the next code update (roughly three years from now). <u>BNBA member and NYSBA Past President Bill Tuyn will represent the builders on the task force</u>.

NYSBA also looked to remove Fire Appendix D from the New York State code due to numerous complaints from members about the requirement of two apparatus access roads for developments over 30 units. The Council took notice of our concerns and stated that this issue can be dealt with on a case by case basis through variances.

The new Residential and Energy codes will go into effect in March 2020. For more information, please contact <u>Lew Dubuque</u>.
