Government Affairs Committee Meeting Updates

The Government Affairs Committee has been working hard on several issues by talking with State, National Associations, and local public officials. A few of these are the NY 2019 Climate Act, local town code-regarding storm water districts and the Condo Bill.

The 2019 Climate Act will start to go into effect come 2024. The outcome and issue to home builders and suppliers of appliances are that gas hook ups and gas usage will be eliminated. Electric energy usages will be the only option for energy. Issue-need a option for heating, cooking, day to day usage.

Storm Water Districts could be made and this would be a resolution to home builders having to maintain ponds in home communities. Another less favorable option is forming a homeowners association to maintain these areas. This would require fees, a board and much more.

The Condo Bill has made it through the Senate, but not made it on to the Budget. This Act would

NYSBA talked with were Senator Gaughan, Senator Ortt, Senator Kavanaugh, Assemblyman Steven Cymbrowitz, Senator Theile, Assemblywoman Peoples-Stokes.


