Notable Points from December 12th Meeting

Committee to meet with Supervisor Majchrzak/Orchard Park-The committee would like to meet with Supervisor Majchrzak regarding Patio home development. Will update when date is set.

NYSEG Wire Shortage- Reported from Michael Pitirri-NYSEG Supervisor Integrated Field Planning. There is an underground wiring shortages. Deliveries are expected in Mid-January. If this causes a problem for anyone, they should work with their field planners to come up with alternative solutions.

*Update by NAHB Chairmen Jerry Konter discloses that NAHB is leading the way including 5 utility companies are urging Congress to use their power in trying to speed up the production of transformers. Transformers that took two months to delivery are now taking up to a year. This is a huge crises that slows down home production. NAHB may need your help as members. Governor Signs Bill Adding Safety Crimes to Penal Law

On December 23, 2022, Governor Hochul signed what is known as Carlos' Law, a bill that increases fines for corporations convicted of crimes involving the death or injury of a worker.

The law establishes that when an agent of a corporation, acting within the scope of their employment, engages in conduct that results in the death or injury of an employee, the corporation could be found guilty of a crime. If the corporation is convicted of a felony the fine shall not be less than \$500,000 or more than \$1,000,000. If the conviction is a class A misdemeanor the fine shall not be less than \$300,000 or more than \$500,000.

☐ A worker died every 101 minutes from a work-related injury in 2021.
□ Suicides continued to trend down,
decreasing to 236 in 2021 from 259 in 2020, an
8.9-percent decrease.
☐ Workers in transportation & material moving
occupations experienced a high of 1,523 fatal
work injuries. This is an increase of 18.8
percent from 2020.
☐ Transportation incidents remained the most

frequent type of fatal event in 2021 with 1,982 fatal injuries, an increase of 11.5 percent from

Work related fatalities due to falls, slips, and trips increased 5.6 percent in 2021, from 805 fatalities in 2020 to 850 in 2021. Falls, slips, and trips in construction and extraction occupations accounted for 370 of these fatalities in 2021, and an increase of 7.2 percent from 2020 when there were 345 fatalities.




