-Senator Ortt and the BNBA did meet on February 27th regarding several areas of concern such as electrification and condo status to name a few.

-There will be a meeting with the Orchard Park Planning Board with intentions of discussing customer and home builder friendly patio homes. Several new regulations need to be discussed. -There will also be a meeting with the ECWA (Erie County Water Authority) regarding unknown price increases. This will be o March 21st.

-There has been some communication questions in working with the Town of Amherst. There will be a meeting with the Building Commissioner on March 6th.

William Morehouse Scholarship is OPEN


