

Government Affairs Corner

Government Affairs Updates & Actions

Notable Points:

Bill Tuyn reported that there will be a Fall Housing Summit that will be taking place near Albany. More details will be coming on this event. This will highlight New Urbanism and include many high profile groups.

Mike Fazio, Executive Vice President of NYSBA attended our Board of Directors meeting and reported on the Condo Bill. This is not in the budget and is at a stand still at this point. Affordable housing continues to be an issue. Electrification has shown to have a negative impact on WNY. The power grid can not handle the amount of electricity that is needed on a day to day basis. Mike gave an example of a home owner putting in a charging station resulting in the neighbor having black outs. A transformer would need to be put at every individual home to accommodate the transition from gas to electric.

Webinar-Lobbying 101-April 11, 2023 Lobby Day is April 25, 2023.

Meeting Notes/Upcoming Meetings:

Town of Amherst meeting was Monday, March 6th.

-The temporary C of O will be pushed back from the May 1 st date. The new date will depend on the weather, it could be June or a July date.

-Make sure the contacts are up to date when status emails go to the home builders. There can be several emails to which information is distributed to.

-Home builders can also sign up for electronic submittals, this is a separate sign on then just being able to see the status of your permits that you are able to see now.

-One last option is that if there are any new project managers that need to be trained on the submittal process, Rich Chudy, Asst. Code Enforcement Officer can do that.

Erie County Water Authority met on March 21st. There was a concern with the rise in fees. These will be sent to the BNBA for early notification. The budget is discussed in November in which time we will be notified of changes. January 1st the new budget goes into effect.

National Fuel-will be meeting on April 18th at 1:30pm in the office on William St. This will be in regards to delay in installation of meters and the use of propane in the interim. If you are interested in attending please contact Jennifer-jennifer@conexbuff.com.

Affordable Energy Poll - Does NY want to keep their natural gas?

The Siena College Research for New Yorkers for Affordable Energy conducted a survey with the climate change and what use of energy will make sense and cost effective. There were several stakeholders that voiced their thoughts and here is just one reaction, to read the results and more details on this poll please click below for the full results. Here are a few points that were taken from the survey.

87% are concerned about the cost of getting away from heating with natural gas, propane or oil. 83% of consumers say they are not willing to pay more then \$100 more a month on their energy bills.

Dottie Gallagher, President/CEO of Buffalo Niagara Partnership spoke of the ban of natural gas being impractical and irresponsible. "New York can and must safeguard both our environment, but in a practical way that safeguards our economy"
