



Government Affairs Updates & Actions

Local Updates:

- Town of Wheatfield-The Town has passed a moratorium for 6 months with the option of a 6 month extension. The reason is big developments and sewer drainage.
- o Town of Orchard Park- There has been a confusion of a fee of \$500 that is given to the town and their Highway Dept. plants trees in new developments. It has since changed to the town not planting the trees and not claiming responsibility that was originally set. The rule has possibly changed again with the decision that the trees may be planted by the town with the stipulation that once they survive a full year, the builder will receive \$400 of the \$500 back. This is being looked into by Phil Nanula and will report back of any changes. A meeting with the Town may be an option.

State and National Updates:

- Housing Summit was a success and there is a publication that is in the works of the event. Once the publication is finished it will be available for the members and other to read it.
- o International Builders Show-was a success. Attendance was up and several new ideas, techniques and electronic advancement was displayed like the new wave of the future in Al.

Update on Electric/Gas via National Fuel Letter Sent to National Fuel Customers



Dear National Fuel Customer,

During a time when natural gas plays such a critical role in our business and our daily lives, National Fuel wanted to take this opportunity to bring awareness to policies being debated in Albany, including the NY HEAT ACT and the Affordable Gas Transition Act, that could impact how Western New Yorkers live - and how employers power their operations. Any proposal that fails to consider the needs of our region and our residents must be rejected.





