#### Local

- Town of Orchard Park- Recently a reminder email was sent over to the Orchard Park Supervisor, Building Dept and the Highway Dept. regarding the planting and funding of the trees. There has been no return acknowledgment of the email.
- Lancaster moratorium is at a standstill, while a few other towns may entertain this.
   It was suggested to possibly join forces with the local Chambers, Realtors and the Erie County Industrial Development Agency to have a united front when issues come up.

#### State and National

o Wetlands and electrification have been the topic in Albany. There has been several discussions between the Governor and the Governors office with NAHB and NYSBA. There are more meetings in the works regarding this topic as well. NYSBA's VP Mike Fazio is reaching out to NAHB trying to maps that outline the wetlands in hopes to bring them back to the towns and local memberships.
