Local

• Town of Orchard Park- Phil Nanula, Bill Tuyn, Andy Romanowski and David Capretto attended a meeting at the Orchard Park Town Hall. This was a work session meeting where they were invited to discuss the possibility of a moratorium. It was a productive meeting with the Board Members and the Town Attorney. Phil handed out copies of the Impact Study and encouraged them to watch the Impact Study Video for the facts on what development of housing does for the economy. On average there are 45 permits per year in Orchard Park and about 20% of them are built on existing roads not newly developed land. Bill also spoke in detail about the study. One councilman expressed that if they put in place a moratorium it would give them time to update the comprehensive plan. It was also expressed from another councilman that they all may not feel the same about putting the moratorium in place.



o Lancaster moratorium- It was reported that Lancaster is having a Moratorium

Committee meeting this week on 10/16. A communication with Joe, a few months back said that they were having a consultant come in and discuss the current moratorium. It was requested that we reach out to the Town later this week asking for an update.

 $_{\odot}\,$ Wheatfield-Ken is meeting with Wheatfield this week and will inquire if a moratorium is in question for the town.

New Business

NYSEG and National Fuel Meetings are being organized. Tentatively, NYSEG will be in the office on Oct. 24th at 10am and National Fuel will tentatively be either on Nov. 7th or Nov. 14th via zoom. Jen will follow up on these dates asap and get them out to the appropriate members.

 It was mentioned that maybe the Impact Study should have an updated version. Bill was going to reach out to NAHB and see what it what take or if it is possible to update the study.


